

## **Future Finance Summit Regulations**

### **§ 1 General provisions**

1. These Future Finance Summit Regulations ("Regulations") set out the general rules for participation in the Future Finance Summit ("Future Finance Summit" or "FFS"), organised by the Foundation for Financial Innovation FinTech Poland, with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. Migdałowa 1, 02-796 Warsaw, registered in the register of associations, other social and professional organisations, foundations and independent public health institutions of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000588844, REGON: 363095315, NIP: 9512401801 ("Organiser").
2. The date, venue, theme and purpose of the Future Finance Summit and the detailed rules for participation are set out at <https://futurefinancepoland.com/future-finance-summit/>.
3. The Future Finance Summit is open to natural persons with full legal capacity ("Participants").

### **§ 2**

1. The FFS is open to those who have registered for the FFS and received an invitation from the Organiser at the email address provided. The number of participants may be limited.
2. Registration for the FFS is made online by completing the registration form at <https://futurefinancepoland.com/future-finance-summit/>.
3. Registration implies acceptance of the rules and consent to the processing of personal data.
4. In the application form, the participant provides the following information: first name and surname, e-mail address, company represented by the participant, position.
5. Participation in the FFS is free of charge. The Participant is responsible for his/her own accommodation and travel costs to attend the FFS.
6. The Participant acknowledges that the FFS will be filmed and photographed by the Organiser for the purpose of promoting, informing or presenting coverage of the FFS. The Participant consents to the use of his/her image and voice captured during the FFS in the form of photographs or films and their dissemination by the Organiser. Consent includes such forms of dissemination as: sharing on <https://futurefinancepoland.com/future-finance-summit/>, social media, FFS promotional materials. The consent refers to the multiple dissemination, unlimited in time and territory, of the image and voice recorded during the FFS.

### **§ 3**

#### **Organizational issues**

1. The Participant may contact the Organiser by e-mail at [info@fintechpoland.com](mailto:info@fintechpoland.com) or by post at the address given in Article 1.1.
2. The agenda for the FFS is available at: <https://futurefinancepoland.com/future-finance-summit/>
3. The Organiser reserves the right to change the agenda, date, duration and venue of the FFS at any time for important reasons or reasons beyond the Organiser's control. The Organiser will publish the changes in the FFS website. Registered Participants will also be notified of any change to the date, duration or venue of the FFS at the e-mail address provided on the registration form.

4. On the day of the FFS, participants will register and collect their badges. Participants must present the invitation to the FFS and display their badge in a visible place.
5. Participants in the FFS are obliged to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of others and to comply with safety regulations, including health and safety regulations, fire regulations applicable to the premises where the FFS takes place, as well as the instructions and organizational and technical orders of the Organiser and the venue manager.

#### **§ 4**

##### **Responsibility**

1. The Organiser is not responsible for any items left behind, lost or stolen during the FFS.
2. The Organiser is not responsible for any damage caused by the Participants during the FFS. The participant in the FFS bears full legal and financial responsibility for any damage caused by his/her actions or omissions.
3. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damage or inability to use or participate in the FFS caused by the Participant's omissions, force majeure, the Participant's failure to comply with technical conditions or the malfunction of the Participant's equipment.
4. In the event of a breach by a Participant of the Regulation, the provisions of generally applicable law relating to the FFS, the Organiser may refuse to allow the Participant to take part in the FFS and, in the event that the FFS has already commenced, expel the Participant from the FFS.

#### **§ 5**

##### **Participant responsibilities**

The Participant undertakes to use and participate in the FFS in accordance with the laws in force in Poland, the rules of social coexistence, the provisions of the Regulations and accepted customs, and in particular not to violate the rights of other FFS participants, the legitimate interests of the Organiser or third parties

#### **§ 6**

##### **GDPR**

1. The Organiser is the Administrator of the Participants' personal data. The Organiser shall process the Participants' personal data in accordance with the provisions set forth in this paragraph.
2. The legal basis for processing the Participant's personal data is Article 6(1)(a), (b), (c), (f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.
3. The purpose of processing the Participant's personal data is to enable the Participant to participate in the FFS. The data will also be processed in connection with the legitimate interests of the Administrator in order to establish, assert and defend claims.
4. The scope of processing of personal data includes name, surname, address, e-mail, company, position, connection data (e.g. IP, web browser).
5. Personal data may be transferred to companies involved in the organisation of the FFS.
6. The Participant's personal data will be stored for the purposes set out in paragraph 4 of this section during the organisation and duration of the FFS and after its completion for the period required by law or until the expiry of the limitation period for contractual claims, whichever is longer.

7. The Participant has the right to request access to, rectification of and, where required by law, erasure, restriction of processing, data portability or to object to the processing of personal data.
8. The Participant has the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of any processing carried out on the basis of the consent prior to its withdrawal. Irrespective of the Participant's consent, the Organiser may also process the Participant's personal data on the basis of another premise set out in paragraph 2 of this section, which constitutes a separate legal basis that is not affected by the withdrawal of consent.
9. The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the purpose stated in paragraph 3 of this section.

## **§ 7**

### **Final provisions**

1. Any disputes arising from participation in the FFS shall be settled by a court having local and substantive jurisdiction over the Organiser's registered office.
2. A Participant may submit a complaint to the Organiser in relation to participation in the FFS. The complaint may be submitted in electronic form and sent to the electronic address [info@fintechpoland.com](mailto:info@fintechpoland.com). In the complaint, the Participant should provide a detailed description of the problem. The Organiser will promptly, but no later than within 30 days, consider the complaint and respond to the e-mail address provided by the Participant in the complaint application, informing the Participant of how to proceed.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the FFS at any time for valid reasons.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Regulations.
5. The Regulations will be effective from 30 August 2023.
