

## GDPR Information clause

In order to comply with the obligation to provide information pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

1. The administrator of personal data is the **Fundacja na rzecz innowacji finansowych FinTech Polska** with its registered office in Warsaw, Migdałowa 1, 02-796 Warsaw, entered into the Register of Associations, other social and professional organizations, the Foundation and independent public health care facilities kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000588844, REGON 363095315, NIP: 9512401801 (hereinafter referred to as the Foundation).
2. Information on personal data in relation to recipients of commercial information:
  - a) Basis for processing personal data**

Personal data is collected by the Foundation and then processed as necessary to fulfill the Foundation's legitimate interest (sending commercial information about the Foundation's activities) and legal obligations.
  - b) Category of personal data processed**

The Foundation processes the recipient's email address.
  - c) Purposes of personal data processing**

Personal data may be processed for the following purposes

    - to send commercial information about the Foundation,
    - in accordance with the requirements of generally applicable laws or in connection with pending legal proceedings or in connection with a request by a public authority to provide information held by the Foundation.
  - d) Retention period of personal data**

Personal data shall be processed for the period of execution of the commercial information mailing, and after its completion - for the period required by law.
3. Information on personal data with respect to persons indicating their data in the contact form:
  - a) Basis for processing personal data**

Personal data is collected by the Foundation and then processed as necessary to fulfill the Foundation's legitimate interests and legal obligations.
  - b) Category of personal data processed**

The Foundation processes name, surname, position, company, e-mail of the recipient.
  - c) Purposes of personal data processing**

The data of persons using the contact form will only be processed for the purpose of answering the question contained in the contact form.
  - d) Retention period of personal data**

Contact data processed for the purpose of dealing with enquiries will be kept for the duration of the correspondence justified by the nature of the enquiry (but no longer than 12 months from the date of completion of the correspondence, unless the limitation period for claims is longer than this until the expiry of the limitation period), or until consent to processing is withdrawn in advance.
4. Information on personal data of persons who have registered for an event organized by the Foundation (ex. FinTech Poland meetup, Future Finance Summit, Poland Asean - FinTech Forum).
  - a) Basis for processing personal data**

Personal data is collected by the Foundation and then processed as necessary to fulfill the Foundation's legitimate interests (in particular to enable participation in the event) and legal obligations.
  - b) Category of personal data processed**

The Foundation processes name, surname, position, company, e-mail of the recipient.
  - c) Retention period of personal data**

Personal data will be processed for the duration of the commercial information mailing and, after its completion, for the period prescribed by law.

5. The Foundation does not process special categories of personal data referred to in art. 9 and 10 of the GDPR.
6. Anyone whose data is processed has the right to withdraw their consent to the processing of their data by the Foundation and:
  - a) access to personal data, obtaining confirmation whether personal data is being processed and obtaining information related to the processing of such data,
  - b) obtain copies of their personal data and request their transfer to another designated entity in a commonly used, machine-readable format,
  - c) rectify personal data when they are incomplete or incorrect,
  - d) deletion of all or some personal data, if the legal basis for the processing of such data has ceased or if the personal data has been processed unlawfully,
  - e) limit the processing of personal data for the time necessary to decide on the legitimacy of the request to remove or rectify the data or for the time necessary to establish, assert or defend claims,
  - f) submitting a complaint against the processing of data by the Foundation to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
7. Withdrawal of consent, request to exercise the rights indicated in points 6.a-e. As well as any other questions regarding the processing of your data may be submitted in the form of:
