

GDPR Information clause

GDPR Information Clause In order to comply with the information obligation under Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (GDPR), we would like to inform you that

1. The administrator of your personal data is **Future Finance Poland Foundation** with its registered office in Warsaw, at Migdałowa Street 1, 02-796 Warsaw, entered in the Register of Associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations, and independent public health care institutions maintained by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under number KRS 0001084713, NIP: 9512589302 (hereinafter referred to as Foundation).
2. The Foundation processes your personal data on the basis of your consent in order to send communications in accordance with the Foundation's statutory purposes.
3. The Foundation processes the following personal data: a) name and surname, b) e-mail address.
4. The Foundation does not process special categories of personal data referred to in art. 9 and 10 of the GDPR.
5. Your data will be processed until you withdraw your consent.
6. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of data by the Foundation, as well as the right to
 - a) Access to personal data, confirmation as to whether personal data is being processed and information relating to the processing of such data,
 - b) obtain a copy of your personal data and request its transfer to another designated entity in a commonly used machine-readable format,
 - c) to rectify personal data if they are incomplete or inaccurate,
 - d) delete all or some of the personal data if the legal basis for the processing of such data has ceased to exist (consent has been withdrawn) or if the personal data has been processed unlawfully,
 - e) to limit the processing of personal data for the time necessary to decide on the legitimacy of the request for deletion or rectification or for the time necessary to establish, assert or defend claims,
 - f) lodge a complaint against the processing of data by the Foundation with the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data,
7. Withdrawal of consent, request to exercise the rights referred to in points 6.a-e. As well as any other questions regarding the processing of your data, you may send them in the following ways
