

Warsaw Finance Week Regulations

§ 1

General provisions

1. These Warsaw Finance Week Regulations ("Regulations") set out the general rules for participation in Warsaw Finance Week or WFW, organised by the Foundation for Financial Innovation FinTech Poland, with its registered office in Warsaw, Migdłowa 1, 02-796 Warsaw, registered in the register of associations, other social and professional organisations, foundations and independent public health institutions of the National Court Register under the KRS number: 0000588844, REGON: 363095315, NIP: 9512401801 ("the Organiser").
2. The date, venue, theme and purpose of the Warsaw Finance Week, as well as the detailed rules of participation, can be found at <https://futurefinancepoland.com/warsaw-finance-week/>
3. The Warsaw Finance Week is open to natural persons with full legal capacity ("Participants").

§ 2

Participants

1. The WFW is open to those who have registered for the WFW and have received an invitation from the Organiser at the email address provided. The number of participants may be limited.
2. Registration for the WFW is made online by filling in the registration form at <https://futurefinancepoland.com/warsaw-finance-week/>
3. Registration implies acceptance of the rules and consent to the processing of personal data.
4. In the registration form, the participant provides the following information: first name and surname, e-mail address, company represented by the participant, position, linkedin profile.
5. Participation in the WFW is free of charge. The Participant acknowledges that the WFW will be filmed and photographed by the Organiser for the purpose of promoting, informing or presenting coverage of the WFW. The Participant consents to the use of his/her image and voice captured during the WFW in the form of photographs or films and their dissemination by the Organiser. Consent includes such forms of dissemination as: sharing on <https://futurefinancepoland.com/warsaw-finance-week/>, social media, WFW promotional materials. The consent refers to the multiple dissemination, unlimited in time and space, of the image and voice recorded during the WFW.

§ 3

Organizational issues

1. The Participant may contact the Organiser by e-mail at info@fintechpoland.com or by post at the address given in article 1.1.
2. The agenda for the WFW is available at: <https://futurefinancepoland.com/warsaw-finance-week/>
3. The Organiser reserves the right to change the agenda, date, duration and venue of the WFW at any time for important reasons or reasons beyond the control of the Organiser. The Organiser will publish the changes on the WFW website. Registered participants will also be notified of any changes to the date, duration or venue of the WFW at the e-mail address provided on the registration form.
4. On the day of the WFW, participants will register and collect their badges. Participants must present the invitation to the WFW and display their badge in a visible place.
5. Participants in the WFW are obliged to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of others and to comply with safety regulations, including health and safety regulations, fire regulations applicable to the premises where the WFW takes place, as well as the instructions and organisational and technical orders of the Organiser and the venue manager.

§ 4 Responsibility

1. The organiser is not responsible for any items left behind, lost or stolen during the WFW.
2. The organiser is not responsible for any damage caused by the participants during the WFW. The WFW participant bears full legal and financial responsibility for any damage caused by his/her actions or omissions.
3. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damage or inability to use or participate in the WFW caused by the Participant's omissions, force majeure, the Participant's failure to comply with technical conditions, or the malfunction of the Participant's equipment.
4. In the event of a breach by a Participant of the Regulations, the provisions of the generally applicable law relating to the WFW, the Organiser may refuse to allow the Participant to take part in the WFW and, in the event that the WFW has already commenced, expel the Participant from the WFW.

§ 5 Participant responsibilities

The Participant undertakes to use and participate in the WFW in accordance with the laws in force in Poland, the rules of social coexistence, the provisions of the Regulations and accepted customs, and in particular not to violate the rights of other WFW participants, the legitimate interests of the Organiser or third parties.

§ 6 GDPR

1. Process the personal data of the Participants in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.
2. The legal basis for processing the Participant's personal data is Article 6(1)(a), (b), (c), (f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.
3. The purpose of processing the Participant's personal data is to enable the Participant to participate in the WFW. The data will also be processed in connection with the legitimate interests of the Administrator in order to establish, assert and defend claims.
4. The scope of processing of personal data includes name, surname, address, e-mail, company, position, connection data (e.g. IP, web browser).
5. Personal data may be transferred to companies involved in the organisation of the WFW.
6. The personal data of the participant will be stored for the purposes stated in paragraph 4 of this section during the organisation and duration of the WFW and after its conclusion for the period required by law or until the expiry of the limitation period for contractual claims, whichever is longer.
7. The participant has the right to access, rectify and, where required by law, erase, restrict processing, portability or object to the processing of personal data.
8. The Participant has the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of any processing carried out on the basis of the consent prior to its withdrawal. Irrespective of the Participant's consent, the Organiser may also process the Participant's personal data on the basis of another premise set out in paragraph 2 of this section, which constitutes a separate legal basis that is not affected by the withdrawal of consent.
9. The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the purposes set out in paragraph 3.

§ 7 Final provisions

1. All disputes arising from participation in the WFW shall be settled by a court having local and substantive jurisdiction at the Organiser's registered office.
2. A Participant may submit a complaint to the Organiser regarding participation in the WFW. The complaint may be submitted in electronic form and sent to the electronic address info@fintechpoland.com. In the complaint, the Participant should provide a detailed description of the problem. The Organiser will promptly, but no later than 30 days, consider the complaint and respond to the e-mail address provided by the Participant in the complaint application, informing the Participant of how to proceed.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the WFW at any time for valid reasons.
4. The Promoter reserves the right to change these rules at any time.
5. These rules will be in force from 30th August 2024.
